Re: Report on the Allegation that San Jose City Officials, the U.S. District Court in San Jose, and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals Obstructed Justice during Litigation of the Case Bates v. City of San Jose et. al. in order to Cover up Discrimination and Racism by the City of San Jose

Dear Senator Schumer:

Enclosed is a report on flash drive documenting my allegation that the above officials obstructed justice during litigation of a lawsuit I filed against the City of San Jose in 2006 for racial and disability discrimination upon my medical disability retirement from the San Jose Police Department as a police sergeant. I am black/African American. It is clear from the report that the discriminatory conduct of San Jose city officials was malicious, retaliatory, and was done with the specific intent to cause me severe emotional distress, and financial loss. It is also clear that San Jose city officials knowingly and intentionally deprived me of due process by violating California law and City policy.

The report presents evidence that San Jose city officials knowingly perpetrated fraud on the U.S. District Court in San Jose and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals during litigation of my lawsuit. Facts and evidence in the report proves that my attorney and judges in the U.S. District Court in San Jose were complicit in the City's fraud. The report establishes that San Jose city officials and officials with the District Court committed several felonies relating to public corruption during litigation of my case. The felonies include, conspiracy to obstruct justice, obstruction of justice, subornation of perjury, perjury, falsifying official government records, and conducting a fraudulent hearing on a motion for relief I filed. It is also unmistakable from the report that the rulings of the District Court and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals are flagrantly biased in favor of the City of San Jose, and thereby, violates the neutrality requirement of the Fifth Amendment Due Process Clause. The report makes it sufficiently clear that the intent of these officials was to obstruct justice and to cover up the City of San Jose's racist and discriminatory acts against me.

I understand that our system of government provides for an independent judiciary, a necessary component of the checks and balances between our co-equal branches of government. However, the independence of our judiciary does not give judges the authority to make rulings that

are intentionally erroneous and inconsistent with the clearly established facts and laws. This is precisely what happened. The report makes this as clear as day.

Additional information is included on the flash drive with my report, including my manifesto, in order to assist you in making a decision whether to seek an investigation into this matter. Please be aware that I am filing an ethics complaint against Congressman Sam Liccardo for his role in this scheme to obstruct justice as a councilmember, and as mayor of the City of San Jose. Also, be advised that I am making complaints regarding this matter with other Members of Congress, the Supreme Court and the Department of Justice.
